Of sun and moon, and that the affrighted globe
Should yawn at alteration.” (Othello, Act V Scene ii, 101-103)

- “Not Cassio kill’d? Then murder’s out of tune,
And sweet revenge grows harsh.” (Othello, Act V Scene ii, 118-119)

Commend me to my kind lord. O, farewell.” (Desdemona, Act V Scene ii, 126-127)
- “You heard her say herself, it was not I.” (Othello, Act V Scene ii, 129)
- “O, the more angel she,
And you the blacker devil.” (Emelia, Act V Scene ii, 133-134)
