- “First to be hanged, and then to confess.” (Othello, Act IV scene i, 39)
- “Work on,
My medicine work. Thus credulous fools are caught,
And many worthy and chaste dames, even thus
All guiltless, meet reproach.” (Iago, Act IV scene i, 44-47)
- “O, Thou art wise; ‘tis certain.” (Othello, Act IV scene i, 74)
- “And let her rot, and perish, and be damned to-night,
For she shall not live.” (Othello, Act IV scene i, 177-178)
- “O Iago, the pity of it Iago!” (Othello, Act IV scene i, 192)
- “I will chop her into messes” (Othello, Act IV scene i, 196)
- “Get me some poison, Iago this night. I’ll not
Expostulate with her, lest her body and beauty
Unprovided my mind again. This night Iago.” (Othello, Act IV scene i, 200-202)
- “Do it not with poison. Strangle her in bed, even
The bed she had contaminated.” (Othello, Act IV scene i, 203-204)
- “I would do much
To atone them, for the love I bear to Cassio.” (Desdemona, Act IV scene i, 227-228)
- “Is it the noble Moor whom our full senate
Call all in all sufficient?” (Lodovico, Act IV scene i, 260-261)

Othello Act IV Scene ii

- “For if she be not honest, chaste and true,
There’s no man happy.” (Emilia, Act IV scene ii, 17-18)
- “I hope my noble lord esteems me honest.” (Desdemona, Act IV scene ii, 66)
- “I will be hang’d if some eternal villain,
Some busy and insinuating rogue,
Some cogging, cozening slave, to get some office,
Have not devis’d this slander. I’ll be hang’d else.” (Emilia, Act IV scene ii, 132-135)
- “Fie, there is no such man, it is impossible.” (Iago, Act IV scene ii, 136)

- “O heaven, that such companions thou’st unfold,
And put in every honest hand a whip
To lash the rascal naked through the world,
Even from the east to the west.” (Emilia, Act IV scene ii, 143-146)
- “Unkindness may do much;
And his unkindness may defeat my life,
But never taint my love.” (Desdemona, Act IV scene ii, 161-163)
- “Why, by making him incapable of Othello’s place
--- knocking out his brains.” (Iago, Act IV scene ii, 229-230)

Othello Act IV Scene iii

- “I would you had never seen him.” (Emilia, Act IV scene iii, 18)
- So would I not, my love doth so approve him
That even his stubbornness, his checks and frowns –
Prithee unpin me --- have grace and favour in them.” (Desdemona, Act IV scene iii, 19-21)
- “If I do die before thee, prithee shroud me
In one of those same sheets.” (Desdemona, Act IV scene iii, 23-24)
- *“Sing all a green willow must be my garland.
Let nobody blame him, his scorn I approve.”* (Desdemona, Act IV scene iii, 50-51)
- “The world is a huge thing. It is a great price
For a small vice.” (Emilia, Act IV scene iii, 67-68)
